General information

Exhibitors requiring electrical services should thoroughly read and understand the rules and regulations.

Determine your electrical requirements:

Equipment

All electrical equipment is stamped or labeled with electrical ratings usually found on the back or bottom of the equipment.

- •Verify voltage and either amperage or wattage from the information provided.
- •Standard office and household items operate on 110/120 volt power.
- •Machinery and equipment typically require 208 or 480 volt power.
- •Separate outlets should be ordered for each piece of equipment.

Refer to the Electrical Services Usage Guide for wattage estimates of some common items.

Lighting

Verify the wattage of the bulbs in the lights and multiply by the number of bulbs/lights.

Uninterrupted power (24-hour power)

- If uninterrupted power supply is required for the full duration of the show, order 24-hour power.
- Electricity is turned on 30 minutes prior to show opening and turned off 30 minutes after the show closes on show days.
- Power will be turned off immediately after final show closing.
- If power is required outside actual show hours, special arrangements should be made in advance.


Location of power in your booth


To accommodate possible power requirements, electrical outlets will be installed in every inline booth. When power is not being provided, an audit will be conducted by electricians and onsite charges will apply if the electrical service is utilized without an order on file.

Exhibitors with hard wall displays must arrange for power to be installed inside the booth or provide access.

Inline and peninsula booths

Power will be installed in one location, typically on the floor somewhere along the back of the booth, as indicated in the following diagrams: (We cannot guarantee that the outlet will be specifically located in the middle.)

If power is required in locations other than indicated above, secondary distribution will be required and billed on a time and material basis. Please order Electrical Labor and include a floor plan indicating the desired power locations.








Island booths/multiple outlets

Floor plans are always required for Island Booths and orders for multiple outlet locations. The floor plan must indicate booth dimensions, surrounding booth numbers for orientation within the facility, each outlet location, required wattage or amperage and location for main drop. If power location in an island booth is not provided prior to show move-in, a location will be determined by PACK EXPO Services to maintain delivery schedules. Relocation of the service will be charged on a time and material basis. See examples below

Labor information

Labor types include the following:

- Floor work: the distribution of electrical under carpet and flooring.
- Booth work: the distribution of electrical overhead and/or throughout the booth structure. Includes but is not limited to: mounting of plasmas / LCD monitors and lights, connection or hard wiring of all exhibitor equipment, installation of electrical headers
 and/or light boxes.
- Electrician: the labor needed to connect machines to high voltage power.
- Labor is required for all electrical work over and above the installation of the main power drop.
- If you require your power from overhead, additional materials and labor charges may be incurred.
- Labor must be picked up at the Exhibitor Service Center. Charges for labor commence at time of dispatch to service the labor call.
- Labor charges will include the time for electricians to gather the necessary tools and materials for the job, have their work checked by the client and return the tools and materials to the supply area.
- Start times are guaranteed only at the start of the workday.
- Overhead Outlet Prices now include lift and labor to bring service to your booth. Any floor work or connection labor will incur
 additional charges.

Lighting information

- Single or double lights stand prices include installation along the side rails of an inline booth. Placement elsewhere will require additional labor and materials.
- Overhead quartz lights include labor and equipment to install and the first focus. Depending on the venue structure or additional restrictions, there may be additional labor and/or lift charges.

Rate information

- Cables that are needed to deliver and distribute electrical to the outlets in booth space, tape, and power strips are included
 in the outlet price which has been adjusted to bundle these into the one rate. Custom materials items like disconnects, transformers, breaker panels, and labor are NOT included in the bundle price.
- Labor rates are based on current wage scales and are subject to change in the event of a wage increase after rates have been published.
- A minimum charge of one hour is applicable to all labor requests. Additional time on the same day is billed in 1/2 hour increments. Continuations to another day are a minimum of 1 hour.
- Dismantle labor will be automatically charged at 35% of the installation time and rounded to the next half hour. There is no need to order electrical dismantle labor. For island booths with no labor ordered, there is a 1 hour minimum installation charge and a 1 hour minimum dismantle charge.
- Power sharing is not permitted between exhibitors.
- Show site rates are applicable to all labor orders placed at show site.

PACK EXPO Services and venue equipment and material information

- Standard wall and other permanent building utility outlets or sockets are not part of booth space and may not be used by exhibitors unless electrical services have been ordered.
- All material and equipment provided by PACK EXPO Services is for rental purposes only and remains the property of PACK EXPO Services. All equipment will be removed at the close of the show by PACK EXPO Services.

Other equipment and material information

- All equipment regardless of power source, must comply with Federal, State and local codes as well as any applicable local recognized electrical authorities and standards. PACK EXPO Services reserves the right to inspect all electrical devices and connections to ensure compliance with all codes and proper permitting. PACK EXPO Services is required to refuse connections where the exhibitor wiring is not in accordance with local electrical code and permitting.
- If electrical services are ordered for LED and/or video display systems, the systems must comply to ANSI E1.50-1. This applies to ground supported and suspended LED and video display systems.
- Exhibitors' cords must be a minimum of 14-gauge 3 wire with ground and must be flat when used for floorwork. All multioutlet devices (e.g., power strips) must have circuit protection. All exposed non-current carrying metal parts of fixed equipment, which are liable to be energized, shall be grounded. Exhibitors may supply their own 14-gauge 3 wire, extension cords and/or power strips, both of which must be grounded, and UL approved.
- Running any electrical cords **over** carpet is **prohibited**. This includes the use of over carpet Wire Covers like the below example. Floor work must be done by PACK EXPO Services electricians.



- Extension cords and power strips owned and used by Exhibitors must comply with the City of Chicago Electrical Code.
- Exhibitors' equipment will be modified to conform to PACK EXPO Services receptacles. If an outage is the result of an exhibitors' equipment, then a labor charge may be assessed. Labor and materials to install or change a cord cap or fix an outage will be billed on a time and material basis.
- Exhibitor provided equipment for electrical distribution or equipment connection shall require PACK EXPO Services to make the final connection from PACK EXPO Service's power distribution equipment to the exhibit. This is required only to ensure proper voltage and connection prior to energizing exhibits and exhibit materials.
- As an exhibitor, should you choose to provide equipment with electrical connectors to plug directly into PACK EXPO Services electrical equipment, the following list provided will ensure the proper connection:

 - 100 Amp 208v & 480v Mini-Cam Male Leviton 15SDM Female 15SDF (Hots Male Neutral & Ground Female)
 - 200 / 400 Amp 208v & 480v Large-Cam Male Hubbell HBL 400PT EKE Female Hubbell HBL 400CT (Hots - Male Neutral & Ground - Female)

East Building:

North Building:





UPPER LAKESIDE CENTER - LEVEL 3



Discount Deadline: September 16, 2024

- Your order with full payment along with a floor plan indicating main power location and distribution points, if applicable, **must be received prior to Discount Deadline date to receive Advance rates**.
- Multiple Outlet Locations: A scaled floor plan is required for orders with multiple outlet locations and/or island booths. (Please see examples of ideal floorplan). If a power location or main drop in an island booth is not provided prior to show move-in, a location will be determined by PACK EXPO Services in order to maintain delivery schedules. Relocation of the service will be charged on a time and material basis.
- Island Booths: For island booths with no labor ordered, there is a 1/2 hour minimum installation charge and a 1/2 hour minimum dismantle charge.
- 24-Hour Services: If an uninterrupted power supply is required for the full duration of the show, please order 24-hour power. Electricity is turned on 30 minutes prior to show opening and turned off 30 minutes after show closes on show days. Power will be turned off immediately after final show closing. If you require power outside actual show hours, special arrangements should be made in advance. Additional charges may apply
- Cables, tape, cords, and power strips are included in the outlet price which has been adjusted to bundle these into one rate. Custom
 material items like quad boxes, disconnects, transformers, or breaker panels, etc. are not included in the bundle.
- Separate Outlets: Separate outlets should be ordered for each piece of equipment and/or each power location.
- Temporary hoist power must be ordered separately and cannot be ordered in conjunction with any other outlet.
- High Voltage Overhead Power: Overhead Outlet Prices now include lift and labor to bring service to booth. Any floor work or connection labor will incur additional charges.
- Power strips are available at the PACK EXPO Services Center for rent, but exhibitors may supply their own.
- **Light Stand Placement:** For single or double light stand, price includes installation if along the side rails of an in-line booth. Placement elsewhere will require additional labor and materials.
- Equipment and Labor cancelled without 24-hour notice will be charged a one (1) hour cancellation fee per Electrician and Condor/ Lift. Cancellations received after installation will be billed at 100%. Please refer to the show Terms and Conditions for additional information.

Plumbing Information

Discount Deadline: September 16, 2024

- To receive advance rate, all orders, payment and accurate floorplan must be submitted by September 16, 2024.
- Determine how many pieces of equipment will need to be connected to either Air, Water, Drain, or Natural Gas.
- Package pricing for services includes: all materials with up to 75' of hose per primary service and an additional 10' per secondary service, labor for transferring location from drawing to floor and installing of services.
- A HOOKUP fee is required for each service: includes Nominal AM. standard air, water, drain, and gas from 1/8" -1". All connections not standard will incur an additional labor and material charge. We do not supply Metric fittings for connections.
- All fill and drain will be on fill and drain service pricing with a minimum of 1 hour labor for filling and draining. All other plumbing
 services such as anchors, welding, grinding, and rental items will be based on time and material.
- All connections from service to equipment will be performed by PES personnel only.
- OVERHEAD OUTLETS ONLY AVAILABLE IN UPPER NORTH (HALL B2) AND LOWER LAKESIDE. ALL OTHER HALLS NEED TO ORDER FLOOR OUTLETS AND INDICATE ON FLOOR PLAN IF YOU WANT A MAIN DROP LOCATION.
- In-line booths and Peninsula booths will have service brought to center back at curtain line if no floor plan is submitted with order. Airline sizes must be confirmed when ordering. If size is not indicated with order, we will provide a minimal size of 1/4" nominal.
- **Island booths requesting service** need to submit a detailed floor plan with order showing where services need to be installed. Without a floor plan, services could be delayed and additional costs incurred.
- After initial services are installed, any changes to installation will be on a new labor ticket and materials order.
- PES is not responsible for moisture, oil, water, drop or increase in pressure in lines to equipment. Exhibitors should provide their own filters, dryers or other equipment as needed.
- No compressors are allowed on the show floor other than those supplied by PES.
- PES reserves the right to size air services by supplied CFM's required for <u>each</u> outlet:

1/4" Line = 1 - 25 CFM @ 90 PSI 1/2" Line = 26 - 60 CFM @ 90 PSI 3/4" Line = 61 - 115 CFM @ 90 PSI 1" Line = 116 - 150 CFM @ 90 PSI

- You must specify line size used per outlet when placing your order. Minimum line size for water and/or drain service is 1/2" nominal.
- All air services shut down one (1) hour after the show closes.
- PES is not responsible for discoloration, taste, sediment or drop in water pressure.
- Pricing Excludes: Ramping which is a time and material cost, any applicable fees or taxes, any above and beyond the normal
 requests for hardware, specific brand products, pressure regulator valve installations, and/or major equipment/machinery retro
 fitting and assembly. Any and all work requested to be done on OT or DT, or any floor or booth work scheduled outside of the
 package scope of work, will be done at the published hourly labor rates and noted on change order or supplemental work
 tickets, which will be signed by the exhibitor(s) as the work is performed and completed.

*** A floorplan is required for all airlines and water/drain outlets. The floorplan needs to show what booths are on each side of exhibitor booth, and indicate where each airline or outlet type is needing to be installed. The quantity of each outlet type ordered needs to match the floorplan. Any revisions for floorplan needs to be submitted by October 10, 2024 or Standard Rates will apply for the total plumbing order.***




- Base airline size needs off of your CFM requirements.
- To avoid possible safety/tripping hazards, if you order a line larger than 1/4", you may need to order carpet padding for under carpet lines; or consider overhead drops instead. Contact your Customer Service Manager for more information.



Target Move-In/Out Material Handling Information

What Is Material Handling? Material handling (drayage) is the process of receiving your materials or equipment either at the advanced warehouse before the show or at show site. The service includes delivering to your booth, removing empty containers for storage during the show, returning the empty containers to your booth after the show, delivering your materials back to the dock, and loading on your outbound carrier for outbound shipping.

All material handling charges for direct shipments are already included in your space rate regardless of weight or number of shipments, provided your shipment/trucks check-in at the PACK EXPO Services (PES) Marshalling Yard by 2:00 PM on your assigned targeted move-in date. This pre-paid fee also includes a one-time spot of equipment and display material. Any additional rigging or booth work will be done at the exhibitor's expense. Exhibitors must be in the booth to take advantage of the one-time spot.

Any freight which requires assembly, un-skidding, uncrating, unbolting, stacking, or special equipment for unloading (including 30,000 lb. forklifts and cranes) and anything else which makes your machinery or freight non-show ready is NOT eligible for the one-time spot. Additional rigging and material handling charges could apply.

NOTE: Space rate includes material handling for the Primary Exhibitor's display material and equipment only. Additional product or equipment not from the Primary Exhibitor is subject to additional billing. Primary Exhibitor is defined as the exhibitor who signs the Exhibit Space Application and Contract.

Targeted Move-In/ Out Information Target dates for all inbound and outbound freight have been assigned to each exhibitor for installation (move-in) and dismantle (move-out). Please click the following links to review your target information: <a href="mailto:target-move-out-note-note-out-note-note-out-note-

Inbound target date and time is for check-in to the Marshalling Yard only. Your truck must be checked in prior to your assigned check-in time. PES recommends drivers arrive at least **2 hours prior** to your assigned time. Target dates apply to machinery and display materials only. Marshalling Yard Hours are 4:00am—2:00pm. Target assignments have been determined by booth size and location on the show floor.

The target check-in time is the deadline for your truck to check-in on your target date. Please note that unloading may take several hours and your carrier will most likely charge for waiting time. **PACK EXPO Services** is <u>not</u> responsible for waiting time charges.

Important: All drayage/material handling is included in your space rate, provided your shipment/truck checks in at the Marshalling Yard by 2:00 pm on your assigned-targeted move-in date and time. A special assessment will apply to off-target shipments (inbound only).

Advance Warehouse: Those exhibitors who ship to the Advance Warehouse will have their materials automatically delivered to their booths by the assigned target date. See the Material Handling rates form for rates.

<u>Target Change Requests:</u> If your company cannot adhere to the scheduled inbound and/or outbound target dates and check-in times assigned, you may <u>request a Target Change</u> from PACK EXPO Services (PES). All requests for changes must be received by Monday, September 16, 2024.

PACK EXPO Services cannot guarantee that your scheduled date can be changed; however, we will try to accommodate your request. PES will notify the exhibitor by email if their target date change has been approved or denied. Please contact PES.Service@packexposervices.com with any questions.

Inbound Shipments

The target floor plans are color-coded to indicate the freight receiving target date assigned to each booth. Please do not arrive prior to your scheduled target move-in date. Due to the high volume of freight, your truck will not be unloaded and will be asked to return on your scheduled day. If materials are not properly identified, they will be classified as display materials.





Target Move-In/Out Material Handling Information

Outbound Shipments

Your assigned outbound target is the day your freight is to be removed from the exhibit hall. The PES Marshalling Yard opens at 4:00 am for outbound shipments. Vehicles must check-in prior to 2:00 pm on their assigned target date. If the carrier's name listed on the outbound material handling agreement does not match the name of the carrier that checks in to pick up your company's freight, it will not be released.

Exhibitors with an outbound target date of Saturday, November 9, 2024, must have their trucks checked-in by 9:00 am.

Exhibitors are assigned a one (1) day outbound targeted move-out. If you need more than one (1) day, please contact PACK EXPO Services.

Exhibitor Freight: Exhibitor freight is under the care and responsibility of the exhibitor until carrier is at the dock and loads your freight on the truck. Staying with your freight ensures that it is all loaded properly without damage. If you have multiple trucks, you must supervise loading of all trucks. **If you choose to leave the show floor prior to your freight being loaded on your carrier, you do so at your own risk. PES will not be responsible for any misloaded or damaged freight if exhibitor is not there to supervise. Please advise carrier they must get out of their truck and supervise the loading of your freight. If they do not get out of their truck to supervise, they your freight will not be loaded.**

MHAs and Labels

Every outbound shipment will require a **Material Handling Agreement (MHA)** and shipping labels. A separate MHA is required for **each outbound shipment**. PACK EXPO Services (PES) provides standard shipping labels. Exhibitors are responsible for providing carrier specific labels.

A pre-printed MHA and shipping labels can be prepared for you in advance and can be delivered to your booth prior to the show close if your information is submitted by **November 5, 2024 at noon.**

IMPORTANT: Your carrier name on the MHA MUST match the carrier name that will be checking in at the marshalling yard. If your carrier name does not match the MHA name, there is a chance that your carrier will NOT be dispatched in a timely manner to pick up your freight and result in waiting time charges from your carrier. (*PES* is not responsible for these charges)

Once onsite and your freight is packed and ready to be loaded on your outbound carrier, return completed Material Handling Agreement(s) to the Exhibitor Service Center. **Do not leave them in your booth with your freight!**

International Shipments

International and Canadian Shipments

Neither PES, PMMI, nor McCormick Place can provide a tax ID number for customs clearance. It is the responsibility of a licensed customs broker to provide this service and insure passage of the show materials into the United States. All freight should be consigned to a certified broker for customs clearance.

Insurance

It is understood that PACK EXPO Services is not an insurer. Insurance has to be obtained by the exhibitor. It is suggested that exhibitors arrange All Risk coverage. This can be done by endorsements to existing policies. Exhibitor's materials should be insured from the time they leave their firm until they are returned after the close of the show. Please contact your Customer Service Manager for further Information.

Personally Operated Vehicles (POVs) POVs must check in at the Marshalling Yard to receive their window card. A POV is defined as a passenger car, pickup truck, or van. Flatbeds 15' or longer, U-Haul's, or other box trucks and vans are not considered POVs, and will be subject to standard material handling rates.

Freight Rigging Information

Advance Planning

- Rigging crews with forklifts or cranes should be ordered in advance to uncrate, unskid, position and re-skid heavy machinery.
- Labor should be ordered in advance to assemble machinery, conveyors and machinery parts, as well as for the leveling of machinery and conveyors.
- Crews do not need to be ordered to unload and reload inbound and outbound freight carriers.
- Crews should not be requested for installation until your heavy equipment has been unloaded and exhibit material is in your booth. **Please note:** Please allow 4-6 hours from the start of your target move-in for your heavy equipment to be unloaded.
- You must provide any special rigging equipment that may be needed to pick, uncrate or assemble your machinery, i.e. special picking bars, rolled steel shafts, special length slings, tested chains, etc. Make sure this equipment is on the back-end of the first truck to be unloaded.
- Plan the layout of your machinery before you come to the show. Submit a copy to PACK EXPO Services
 prior to arrival to showsite.

Machinery Skids Removal

- Rigging crews will remove and return machinery crates and skids as part of fulfilling rigging labor orders placed by exhibitors.
- IF MACHINERY SKIDS ARE NOT READY TO BE REMOVED AT THE TIME ASSEMBLY IS FINISHED, YOU MUST RETURN TO THE SERVICE CENTER AND PLACE AN ORDER FOR MACHINERY SKIDS TO BE REMOVED AT THE EXHIBITOR'S EXPENSE.

On-Site Execution

- Rigging crews ordered in advance for installation and dismantling of heavy machinery MUST be reconfirmed upon arrival to the exhibit hall at a PES Exhibitor Service Center.
- Union laborers are ordered by PACK EXPO Services prior to 2:30 pm daily for the next day. Therefore, you
 must place your order, or reconfirm your existing order at a PES Service Center prior to 2:00 pm for the
 following day.
- You must provide any special tools, i.e. socket and Allyn wrenches, metric tools, etc. Riggers only carry a
 twelve-inch crescent wrench, knife and ruler.
- During move-in, please <u>DO NOT</u> sign out your crews until your machinery skids are removed. If machinery skids are not ready to be removed at the time assembly is finished, you must return to the Service Center and place an order for machinery skids to be removed at exhibitor's expense.
- Union laborers work according to the following schedule:
 - If you order crews for 8:00 am, every effort will be made to have them there in your booth by 8:10 am. This includes any work that will be carried over from day prior.
 - There is no guarantee for an automatic 8am start time for the 1st day of move-out after show
 close for all crews due to volume of requests and will be dispatched prioritizing exhibitors with the
 earliest target move-out dates.
 - Fifteen minute breaks at 9:30 am and 2:30 pm.
 - Thirty minute lunch break from 12:00 noon to 12:30 pm.
 - Return labor by 4:15 pm daily to avoid overtime charges, and allow time for wash-up.
- TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE SAVINGS: Forklift crews on night of show close from 3pm-10pm are billed at straight time.
- Machinery skids will not be returned automatically to your booth. You must use your forklift crew to
 retrieve your machinery skids from storage. Please take note of where your machinery skids were located
 when putting into storage.

- Based on the information on bill of lading or delivery receipt.
- Date and time stamped.

Once a driver has checked in, a numbered card will be given to them for placement in the window of their vehicle. The numbered card identifies the building and area in which they will be unloaded. The driver will be advised when to proceed to their designated area. The numbered card must be displayed in the vehicle's windshield at all times.



All Drivers must provide the following details on their Bills Of Lading (BOL):

- 3. Shipper's Name
- 4. Piece Count Summary
- 5. All drivers must provide a certified scale ticket to check-in
- 6. Net, Gross and Tare Weight

Piece count summaries must be broken down into the following categories:

 Carpets (Rugs and Pads)

4. Skids (Pallets)

6. Machines

Certified weight tickets will be required.

ALL BILLS OF LADING MUST CONTAIN THIS INFORMATION BEFORE THEY CAN BE ACCEPTED FOR DRIVER CHECK-IN

Drivers that are unable to provide any of the requested information must contact their dispatch to get the necessary information to be checked in for unloading.

OUTBOUND Driver Check-in Requirements

All Drivers must present the following information to pick up freight from a show:

- 1. Booth Number
- 2. Exhibiting Company's Name
- 3. Shipment Destination (City and State)
- 4. Carrier's (or Broker's) Name
- 5. Location or area the vehicle is parked
- 6. Driver's Cell Phone Number
- There may be a wait time before the freight is ready to be picked up.
- Please wait in the Marshalling Yard until you are dispatched for loading by the Freight Clerk.

Drivers that are unable to provide any of the required information for check-in must contact their Dispatch for assistance.

EXHIBITOR FREIGHT: Exhibitor freight is under your care and responsibility until your carrier is pulled up to the dock and PES comes to your booth and picks up the freight. With a show this size and the amount of freight that is on the show floor at one time, exhibitors must stay with their freight to make sure it is all loaded properly without damage. If you have multiple trucks, you must remain with your freight to insure all your freight is loaded properly and correctly to the designated trucks.



Please read the following guidelines, carefully to avoid problems with US Customs, thus jeopardizing the timely arrival of your shipment at your booth at PACK EXPO International 2024.

International shipments will require special consideration NOT covered in the handling and shipping section of your exhibitor manual for PACK EXPO International 2024. DSV Air & Sea Inc. as your logistics partner is available to you and advise the best method of transportation to/from the USA, including recommendations for shipping lines, airlines and inland carriers. In addition, we will advise on the proper documentation required to facilitate customs clearance and delivery procedures.

CUSTOMS CLEARANCE

The following types of US Customs entries are offered for importation into the USA:

Consumption Entry/Permanent Entry

This type of customs entry is recommended on all items in your shipment, which will remain permanently in the USA – i.e. – giveaway items, such as brochures, small gifts to potential customers as well as machinery, which has been sold to US companies prior to shipment.

Trade Fair Entry (TFE)

PACK EXPO International 2024 has been designated as a bona fide trade fair under the Trade Fair Act (TFA) of 1959, by the US Department of Commerce. Under the TFA, international shipments may enter the USA on a temporary basis without payment of duties for a period of 90 days. Within this time frame, shipments may be sold to US companies or they may be returned to their country of origin or any other destination outside the USA.

Carnet ATA

A Carnet ATA may be used for all shipments, which are meant for re-export. Consumable/giveaway items should not be included in a Carnet ATA. Such items would have to be covered under a commercial invoice to be used for a consumption entry. US Customs will not accept a permanent entry from a Carnet ATA.

Remarks:

All shipments customs cleared under the Trade Fair Entry, will be customs cleared in the name of the show organizer (PMMI). These shipments will be covered by the trade fair bond. A continuous bond for such entries is not accepted by US Customs.

Shipments, which are cleared under consumption/permanent entries (consumables, giveaways and sold items), will be cleared in the name of the US Buyer or the exhibitor. US Buyers have the option to utilize their assigned brokers or they may use the DSV Customs clearance services. Overseas exhibitors without US Representation will be able to utilize the DSV clearance services, as well.

TERMS OF DELIVERY

To assure timely delivery to the exhibition-site dock, marshaling yard or advance warehouse, all shipments must arrive at the below mentioned dates at their designated US Ports and/or airports of arrival. PACK EXPO International 2024 has a target move-in schedule, which assigns each exhibitor a specific date and time, when the shipment may be delivered to the show venue. The first day of set up for PACK EXPO International 2024 is **OCTOBER 28, 2024.** Based on this information we recommend the following dates for arrival of shipments in the USA.

DOCUMENTATION

Separate invoices should be issued for each shipment and/or import mode (temporary import vs. permanent import). US Customs prefers that each exhibitor uses their in-house invoice forms, however, for your convenience, we have attached our "generic" invoice form, which includes all information; we require to perform the customs clearance.

Without such arrangements, DSV in the USA will need to receive full payment of all charges, prior to customs clearance and delivery to PACK EXPO International 2024.

**** if any of your consumable/giveaway items for this show include any wearing apparel, such as T-shirts, baseball caps etc., we will need the full name and address of the manufacturer of such products, in addition to applicable forms, such as textile declarations.

Please refrain from sending any of the following items to PACK EXPO International 2024 in Chicago, unless you have the proper permits from the applicable US Government Agencies such as the FDA, USDA, ATF, DOT, EPA, FCC etc. Just to name a few of our OGA's involved in the importation of certain products:

- Any type of food and beverages
- Alcoholic beverages
- Tobacco products
- Cosmetics
- Pharmaceuticals and medical devices, instruments etc.
- Agricultural products, including flowers and seeds, wooden products
- Functioning parts of any type of conveyance, unless they are "true" dummy items
- Leather products and other clothing
- Radio transmitters or receivers
- Restricted telecommunication equipment
- · Weapons and ammunitions

If you are not sure if any of your products could be import restricted, please contact us for further clarification. Thank you.

IMPORTER SECURITY FILING (ISF) - OCEAN SHIPMENTS, ONLY:

Effective January 26, 2009, US Customs requires for all ocean freight shipments arriving via U.S. Ports are subject to Import Security Filing (ISF). Upon request DSV will be able to file ISF in your behalf, in which case we would require your Customs Power of Attorney Form and completed ISF Filing form (both forms are available upon request)

All ISF Filing information has to be submitted to US Customs, at least 3 days prior to sailing from the origin port. Failure to comply will result in late filing penalties of minimum US\$ 5000.00 per shipment. In addition, on late filings DSV will no longer be able to provide the ISF bond, in which case the Importer of the shipment (either exhibitor or US buyer) have to issue a Letter of Credit with US Customs being the beneficiary in the L/C. Late ISF filings will also result in delays at the ports and in delays with the customs release.

Late filing penalties are directly issued and sent to the Importer of Record in the USA (either the exhibitor or the US buyer). For Carnet ATA's the penalty notice is being sent to the Carnet holder.

PACKING

Please make sure that all your machines and show items are packed in re-useable cases, crates, boxes etc. This will facilitate packing and un-packing procedures and it will save you money, since re-useable packing is unlikely to be damaged during the unpacking at the beginning of the show. In detail, please allow us to make the following recommendations:

- 1. All cases or crates should be bolted as opposed to nailed or screwed. (Please include spare bolts in your shipment.
- 2. All cases or crates should be fitted with sling irons or skids
- 3. Center of gravity should be marked on all cases exceeding a weight of 1000 kg
- 4. If possible, do not use plywood as packing material for heavy machinery, since it cannot be properly repaired, once damaged
- 5. Machinery should be barrier bagged/vacuum packed
- 6. If machinery is bolted to the shipping skids, all nuts must be on the upper side of the base.

Effective September 16, 2005, the US Dept. of Agriculture (USDA) revised the import regulations for wood packing materials (WPM). The new regulation requires WPM coming into the USA to be treated and marked, accordingly. If your WPM is not properly treated and/or marked, your cargo is subject to immediate export from the USA. SOLAS/VGM - RETURN OCEAN FREIGHT - FCL SHIPMENTS

Effective July 1, 2016, the International Maritime Organization (IMO) has issued a mandatory amendment to the International Convention for Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS) Chapter VI, Part A, Regulation 2 – Cargo Information.

As the acronym SOLAS implies, the purpose of the rule is to maximize safety by properly developing strategic vessel load plans for weight distribution. The gist of the new regulation is that the shipper/exhibitor of a packed container received for transportation (gate-in or off rail) is required to provide the containers gross verified weight (VGM) to the ocean carrier and port terminal representative prior to its being loaded onto a ship. The vessel operator and the terminal operator will be required to use this VGM in vessel stowage plans and are prohibited from loading a packed container aboard a vessel for export, if the container does not have a VGM.

Since international exhibitors in the PACK EXPO 2024, will not have any opportunity to get the VGM for their return containers, DSV Air & Sea, Inc. will get the VGM Certification for return containers by having the containers re-weighed at certified VGM scales. To cover scale fees and administrative cost, DSV will charge a flat fee of US\$ 50.00 per container for VGM Certification.

INSURANCE

We strongly suggest securing insurance coverage for your goods throughout the entire shipping process with a door to door coverage, including while on display during the PAXK EXPO 2024. If your exhibition goods are meant to be returned to origin, after the show, please make sure that the return transport is covered as well. On sold machines to US companies, the insurance coverage to the buyers' plant should be discussed with your buyer, as well.

DSV Air & Sea, Inc. will be more than happy to provide door to door insurance coverage for your valuable products. Please contact us for our competitive insurance services.

Please note that a shipment, which is located inside your booth or around your booth area (during set-up and tear-down) is considered as being in your custody, even, if your company representative is not in the booth. It is therefore, strongly recommended to have insurance coverage, while the products are on display and during the set-up and tear down periods.



COST ESTIMATES, **SHIPPING ORDERS & SECURITY ENDORSEMENTS**: Rock-It Cargo requires that our customers or their agents receive a written cost estimate of their charges based on the information provided by the exhibitor or their agent. If the customer or their agent accepts the cost estimate, they or their agent must provide Rock-It Cargo with a written confirmation (for inbound charges) or a signed shipping order and security endorsement (for outbound charges) as well as a valid US Customs power-of-attorney and a completed Rock-It Cargo customer application/agreement. All cost estimates are subject to Rock-It Cargo's terms, conditions, limits of liability and instructions. The actual charges billed are based on the actual weight, dimensions, value, circumstances and other factors of an actual shipment.

ALL RETURN AIRFREIGHT IS HANDLED PER TSA REGULATIONS AS 'UNKNOWN SHIPPER' CARGO AND THEREFORE, CANNOT BE SHIPPED ON PASSENGER AIRCRAFT. The exhibitor or their on-site representative must have their outbound freight packed, labeled and documented as per Rock-It Cargo's instructions to insure prompt pickup of the outbound freight.

- TRADEMARK, COPYRIGHT & OTHER INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY WARNING: Exhibitors and their suppliers
 must be able to demonstrate upon request that they have a clear license to use trademarks, copyright and other
 intellectual property that is displayed or otherwise used by the exhibitor.
- Motor vehicles and engines are subject to regulation by the <u>U.S. Environmental Protection Agency</u> and the <u>U.S. Department of Transportation</u>. Please contact us in advance of shipping to learn about the entry requirements for these commodities.
- 3. MEDICAL DEVICES & EQUIPMENT: All shippers and exhibitors of medical devices must be registered with the U.S. Food & Drug Administration and provide us with their FDA Medical Devise Establishment Number. And we must know the FDA assigned Medical Device Listing Number for each medical device or equipment shipped. Medical devices and equipment that are not fully registered and listed may only be entered temporarily into the U.S. on an ATA Carnet or a temporary import entry in the name of the shipper or exhibitor.
- 4. <u>U.S. FOOD & DRUG ADMINISTRATION REGISTRATION & PRIOR NOTICE:</u> ALL cosmetics, food, beverages and drug ingredients (including animal including fish feed) products are subject to the U.S. Bioterrorism Act. This requires that the shipper register with the U.S. Food & Drug Administration (FDA) and provide Rock-It Fairs with an official prior notice made through the FDA's website. If the origin freight forwarder or shipper is unable to do this themselves, then contact in advance for help for a fee. Furthermore, we request that all exhibitors sending health aids, toiletries and other sundries obtain approval from us in advance of shipping.
- FOREIGN SUPPLIER VERIFICATION PROGRAMS (FSVP): Food and beverage products excluding fish, fishery
 products, juices, alcoholic beverages, certain meat, poultry and egg products must be documented with a FSVP.

The shipper must provide the name and details of their FSVP U.S. Importer of Record. If the product being imported into the U.S. is subject to FSVP requirements and the shipper cannot comply, then we recommend contacting the Registrar Corp for assistance no later than 2 months in advance of shipping.

- 6. Exhibitors are encouraged to deal directly with the general contractor to settle their showsite material handling charges before the close of the event. Showsite material handling and deliveries or pickups that occur on the weekend or holiday are subject to overtime surcharges.
- 7. Exhibitors must contact Rock-It Global prior to the close of the event for instructions on how to properly complete the general contractor's outbound material handling agreement or form. Failure to do so can lead to delay and additional cost.
- 8. Equipment that emits radiation (including CRT's, lasers, DVD/CD devices and all microwave emitting devices must be registered and cleared through the <u>U.S. Food & Drug Administration (FDA)</u>. The exhibitor or their forwarder must forward to us sufficient information to complete FDA Form 2877.
- 9. If you intend on shipping any piece of cargo that weighs more than 19300 kilos or has dimensions greater than 12 meters long, 2.1 meters wide and/or 2.1 meters tall, please check with us in advance as this cargo may require special handling, escorts or permits.
- 10. Material being sent on an ATA carnet via ocean freight must include the carnet number and number of items listed on the carnet to be transmitted via AMS from origin by the steamship line or NVOCC to avoid delays with US Customs.
- 11. COURIER SHIPMENTS: Contact us in advance for special instructions for sending material either to the advance receiving warehouse or showsite via small package express services such as Federal Express, UPS or DHL.

SHOWSITE CARGO HANDLING NOTICE: Because of limited space at the venue, we are requesting exhibitors and their stand builders to adhere to the following standards as a courtesy to their fellow exhibitors:

- 1. If the move-in or move-out occurs on overtime, then overtime rates for material handling, labor and delivery/pickup apply. Please plan and budget accordingly. Please consult the target move-in and move-out schedules in the Exhibitor Service Manual.
- 2. Deliveries to and pickups from the showsite are subject to waiting time. Expect, on the average, from two to six hours of truck waiting time. We recommend moving freight to and from the event via the general contractor's warehouse.
- Avoid keeping crates and cases in the aisles any longer than strictly necessary. Floor Managers and other Show Management personnel will be politely encouraging exhibitors and their stand builders to not hold onto crates and cases blocking the aisles unless strictly necessary. Exceptions would be made for items such as tool boxes.
- 4. Freight delivered on any given date should be emptied and empty stickers with the correct color code attached by the end of the day when that particular piece of cargo has been delivered so the empty crate or case can be taken away for storage and not block the aisles.
- 5. Please do plan on empty case return to take 6 or more hours after the close of the show. Plan your dismantling labor accordingly.
- 6. We encourage all pavilions and large booth exhibitors to submit in advance a freight and empty handling plan to the general contractor in advance.



Cancellation by Exhibitor

Cancellations received after a contract has been signed, will be charged at 50% of the Total Bill. Cancellations received 14-days or less before the show will be charged at 100% of the Total Bill. (a) Exhibitor acknowledges and agrees to the CANCELLATION CHARGES set forth in the contract. If Exhibitor, or Agent on behalf of Exhibitor, cancels prior to the event, the Exhibitor will be subject to this Agreement. Upon such cancellation, Exhibitor/Agent excuse Event Pros, LLC and Talent from further performance under the terms of this Agreement. (b) The Exhibitor acknowledges and agrees that the Exhibitor or its Agent may only terminate or cancel Talent after commencement of the event subject to the Agreement, upon showing a good cause. "Good cause" is defined as a willful breach of duty by the Talent in the course of his or her performance, or in the case of the Talent's habitual; neglect of duty or continued incapacity to perform that duty. In the event of good cause as defined above, prior to terminating cancelling the Talent, the Exhibitor must provide Event Pros with a reasonable opportunity to cure the inadequate performance of the Talent by allowing Event Pros to notify the Talent of the alleged breach of duty and/or replacing the Talent with an alternate in order to rectify any performance inadequacies. In the event Exhibitor terminates or cancels Talent without providing Event Pros with the aforementioned opportunity to cure, the Exhibitor agrees to pay the entire fee due and owing as if the Exhibitor and Talent fully performed under the Agreement.

Indemnification

The Exhibitor shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless Event Pros, LLC from and against any and all obligations, debts, liabilities, claims, demands, losses, damages, lawsuits, and expenses of any third party in any way arising out of the services to be provided; however, such indemnifications shall not apply to acts of omissions of Event Pros, LLC which constitute willful misconduct or gross negligence.

No Solicitation by Exhibitor

The Exhibitor shall not solicit for employment or employ, nor refer to a third party for employment or employ, whether as employee or independent contractor, any person who is or has been provided to the Exhibitor through the services of Event Pros, LLC for a period of (2) years after the completion of any event for which Event Pros, LLC served as the booking agent.

Services to be Performed

Personnel retained by the Exhibitor will perform the specific duties described in the work order confirmation and will not be subjected to any undue emotional, physical, or sexual harassment from the Exhibitor and/or the Exhibitors' guests. Any such harassment will necessitate the withdrawal of personnel. The Exhibitor shall remain fully liable for payment of the total fee should such a withdrawal occur.

- All staff may go through employee health screening upon arrival prior to reporting to their assigned area.
- Proper distancing of staff and product in food preparation areas accordingly.
- Implemented cleaning and disinfecting protocols that focus on high contact/touch points both in back and front of house.

MENU & SERVICE UPDATES

- Increased options for pre-packaged food and beverage products.
- Adjusted menu items where applicable to be displayed in individual portions instead of bulk.
- Increased action stations with chef to individually prepare items over buffet service.

POLICIES

OVG Hospitality is the exclusive food and beverage provider for McCormick Place Convention Center. All food and beverage items must be supplied and prepared by OVG Hospitality. No food or beverage of any kind is permitted into the facilities by the patron or any of the patron's guests or invitees (exclusive of Exhibitor Personal Consumption Policy). Food items may not be taken off the premises; however, excess prepared food is donated under regulated conditions to agencies feeding the underprivileged.

MENU SELECTION

The menus have been designed to maximize the guest's satisfaction. To assure availability of menu items, please provide the Catering Sales Manager with the food and beverage selections a minimum of three (3) weeks prior to the first function. Every effort will be made to accommodate requests for special, religious or dietary requirements that OVG Hospitality is made aware of.

PRICING

Published pricing does not include administrative fees (21.5%) or applicable taxes. A good faith estimate of food and beverage prices, will be provided in advance of the event's start date and will be confirmed at the signing of the contract. However, due to fluctuating market prices, we reserve the right to make product substitutions based on specific commodity price increases. OVG Hospitality reserves the right to make menu substitutions and revise the style of service due to supply interruption and/or health and safety regulations caused by any health crises that may arise. Please discuss the styles of service for all buffet services and the additional costs with your Catering Manager.

SERVICE CHARGES

All catered events are subject to a 21.5% management fee. 21.438% of this Management Charge is distributed as tips/gratuities to the employees who provide service to guests in connection with the catered event. The remaining 1.562% of this Management Charge is the sole property of the McCormick Place, as applicable, is used to cover that party's costs and expenses in connection with the catered event and the administration of the event (excluding employee tips, gratuities, and wages), and is not charged in lieu of a tip or gratuity. This portion of the Management Charge is not a tip or gratuity, nor is it purported to be a tip or gratuity, for any employee who provides service to guests (e.g., wait staff employee, service employee, service bartender, and the like), and no part of this portion of the Management Charge will be distributed (as a tip, gratuity, or otherwise) to any employee who provides service to guests.

GUARANTEES

In order to ensure the success of the function(s) and the satisfaction of the guests, food and beverage quantity guarantees must be received by the Catering Sales Manager no later than five (5) full business days (Monday through Friday) prior to the event for functions up to 1,000 guests. Functions of 1,001 guests or more must be guaranteed ten (10) full business days prior to the event. Functions with 5,000 guests or more must be guaranteed fifteen (15) full business days prior to the event. The Customer may be required to provide a guarantee earlier if special products or preparations are required. If the guarantee is not received, OVG Hospitality reserves the right to charge for the expected number of guests or quantities specified on the Banquet Event Order(s). If the attendance is higher than the given guarantee, the charge will be for the actual function attendance. Increases and/or new orders made within three (3) days (72 hour processing fee) of the function are subject to an additional 20% fee based on the menu price.

OVG Hospitality will prepare to serve 3% over the final guarantee (for seated meal functions only) up to a maximum of 30 guests. The Customer will be charged for the greater of the actual number of guests served as the final guarantee amount. OVG Hospitality reserves the right to make reasonable menu substitutions, as necessary. Functions requiring over preparation greater than 3% will be subject to additional labor fees.

SERVICE STAFF

Guest to server ratio is based on the type of function. The standard is one (1) server per twenty (20) guests for plated meal functions and one (1) server per forty (40) guests at buffet functions. Additional health and safety regulations may be implemented requiring additional service should any health crises arise. Please discuss the styles of service for all buffet services and the additional costs with your Catering Sales Manager. For additional staffing requests or guarantees for less twenty-five (25) guests for plated or buffet functions, labor fees will be applied. Holiday labor rates may apply.

EVENT TIMELINE

Breakfast and lunch are based on up to a three (3) hour service and dinner is based on up to four (4) hours of service. Extended service time will be subject to additional labor fees. Function start or end times that deviate more than thirty (30) minutes from the time indicated on the Banquet Event Order will have additional labor fees per hour, per server scheduled.

BEVERAGES

OVG Hospitality offers a complete selection of beverages to compliment your function. Alcoholic beverages and services are regulated by the Liquor Control Board. OVG Hospitality, as licensee, is responsible for the administration of these regulations. No alcoholic beverages may be brought onto the premise from outside resources, nor may it be removed from the premises. We reserve the right to refuse alcohol service to intoxicated or underage persons. Where applicable, Customer is responsible to pay all minimum sales guarantees included on Banquet Event Orders. Customer will receive credit for retail sales, not to exceed amount of minimum sales guarantee listed on the Banquet Event Order for that function.

PAYMENT/DEPOSIT/CONTRACTS

An initial deposit in the amount noted on the Catering Contract is due on the date specified. The amount of this deposit is 50% of the estimated catering expenditure based on planned functions. The signed contract and deposit are due forty-five (45) days in advance of the event. The actual revenue will be based on the signed Banquet Event Order(s) and guarantee(s). The remaining balance of the deposit is due fourteen (14) business days in advance of the first function. A 3.5% fee will be assessed on all payments made by credit card of \$5,000.00 or more. This fee will be due at the time of credit card payment and is non-refundable. No transaction fee will be assessed on payments made by check or ACH.

CANCELLATIONS

In the event that a group should cancel with McCormick Place, the catering deposit will be refunded based on a sliding scale. Please refer to the Catering Contract for specific details. In the event that a function cancels after the guarantee date, payment in full for the estimated revenue based on the menu and event arrangements are required.

RETAIL/CONCESSIONS SERVICE

Appropriate operation of concessions outlets will occur during all show hours. OVG Hospitality reserves the right to determine which carts/outlets are open for business and hours of operation pending the flow of business. Should additional service locations be requested, a minimum sales guarantee and related fee may apply.


